

BEACH RULES AND REGULATIONS

Hours of operation: 12pm – dusk Sunday thru Saturday, weather and beach conditions permitting.

Follow all instructions by lifeguards.

The beach water is not suitable for drinking. Avoid drinking beach water.

Admission to the beach is refused to all persons having any contagious disease, infectious conditions.

Littering is prohibited. No food, drink, gum, or tobacco will be allowed in the water.

No glass, metal, fires or portable cookers allowed in beach areas.

Do not swim alone.

Parents and guardians are responsible for the supervision of children. Adults must accompany children under the age of 9.

All children who are not toilet trained shall wear tight fitting rubber or plastic pants. Approved swim diapers will be allowed.

No pets are permitted in the beach area.

No fishing within swimming area.

Feeding of wildlife or other actions that encourage their presence is prohibited.

Alcohol is not permitted in Park Grounds or Beach Area.

US Coast Guard Personal Flotation Devices are allowed.

Stay within the designated swimming area.

Beach patrons are not allowed on lifeguard towers, chairs, buoys, etc.

No throwing rocks, sand or seaweed.

No rough-housing or fighting.

Swimming is prohibited after sunset or before sunrise, or when lightning is present, including a 20 minute period after the last lightning is observed.
